CALADESI ISLAND STATE PARK – Sun, 3 August • 9 am - 5 pm or
Sun, 7 September • 9 am - 5 pm

Cost: \$25 per person. Picnic in the park and play on the beach all day! Caladesi Island State Park boasts one of Florida's top beaches. This lovely, relatively secluded beach with fine soft sand is edged in sea grass and palmettos. Dolphins often cavort in the waters offshore. A nature trail, concession stand, ranger station, and bath houses with restrooms/showers are available in the park. This park is only accessible by a 30 minute ferry ride from Honeymoon Island Recreation Area. Bring your own picnic lunch or purchase lunch from the concession stand. Please register NLT Mon, 28 Jul/Fri, 29 Aug. (Need 10; can take 24 people.)

CEDAR KEY TRIP – Sat, 9 August • 7 am - 5 pm • Cost: \$45 per person. Leave from the Marina at 7 am and depart the coast at 5 pm for the ride home. Here, you are on "Island Time", the best time of all. Step back and explore 200 years of island history. The Cedar Key State Museum presents exhibits ranging from Indian artifacts to folklore, as well as, the natural history of the area. There is a lot to see as you stroll the streets and relax at the City Dock. We will also tour the Clam Bed Farm where you'll learn how clams are raised. You may also purchase clams if you desire. Lunch will be "Dutch treat" at the restaurant of your choice. Please register NLT Mon, 28 Jul. (Need 12 people; can take 24.)

DEEP SEA FISHING TRIP – Sun, 10 August • 5:30 am - 6 pm • Cost: \$75 per person. Meet at the Marina Activity Room at 5:15 am and depart at 5:30 am sharp. Join us for a day of fishing on the "Miss Virginia" based in Port Richey. The boat has an enclosed cabin with seats and tables. Breakfast and lunch are available at a reasonable cost, as well as, beer, soda, and snacks. Fishing rods, license, tackle, and bait for each fisherman are supplied, although you are welcome to bring your own. If you prefer to fish with live bait, it must be purchased that morning before departure. You may bring a small cooler (no larger than 48 quarts). **NO GLASS CONTAINERS PLEASE.** Register and pay at the FamCamp office NLT noon on Wed, 6 Aug. (Need 10 people; can take 24.)

All trips leave from the Marina Activities Room.
